

## Hard to Recycle Items

Did you know there are collections points for lots of 'hard to recycle' items locally to All Saints?

Don't forget to **reduce and reuse** before recycling! You may also be able to get items repaired at:

- [The Ilkley Thingery](#) which is at 10 Church Street, Ilkley, just a few doors down from All Saints. You can also borrow all sorts of items from their 'library of things' - a great alternative to buying, especially when you only need something for a short period of time!
- The Repair Cafe at [Silsden Methodist Church](#), Wesley Place, Silsden on the 3rd Saturday of each month.

- Boots branches, including the [Ilkley store](#) on Brook Street, provided it is an item that they sell - hand item to a member of staff. We understand that you do not need to be buying a replacement.
